Please Help Make Recycling a **TOUCHDOWN** at FSU Football Games

The FSU Athletic Department, in collaboration with the FSU Sustainable Campus & Community Committee, is pleased to announce the continuation of the Recycling Program at all home football games this season. During the past two seasons, over **15.6 tons** (31,200 pounds) of recyclable materials were collected in and around the stadium.

As you cheer your Seminoles on to victory please consider the following:

- **Tailgaters:** Bring trash bags to dispose of your trash. Neatly tied trash bags can be left at your tailgate area or be taken home for disposal. Also, there will be recycling stations available in the stadium parking lots.
- **On your way to the game:** Recycle your aluminum, glass, and plastic beverage containers in the recycling stations located outside every gate around Doak Campbell Stadium. FSU students will be available at the stations to assist you with your recycling efforts.
- **During the game:** Encourage your fellow fans to recycle. These efforts will help to reduce the amount of trash and litter around the stadium.
- **After the game:** Support members of the FSU ROTC and other students who clean up after the game inside the stadium by placing your recyclable materials (plastic bottles and plastic cups) on your seat. Please remember to help us by disposing of your trash properly.

Let's all do our part to keep FSU's campus and stadium beautiful. We are making great progress, but there is still much more that can be done. Don't be caught *sitting on the sidelines* when it comes to RECYCLING.
