## Harvey Rundquist Memorial Scholarship

PENSACOLA, Fla. – The Harvey Rundquist Memorial Scholarship has been established in the name of the much loved and respected instructor who retired from Pensacola Junior College in 1993 and recently passed away.

The scholarship honors Rundquist's memory with the creation of an annual endowed scholarship. By reaching a total goal of \$5,000, the State of Florida matches the gifts. The scholarship is awarded to art majors and is applied to the costs of college tuition and books.

Rundquist, who taught painting, drawing and design at PJC from 1963 to 1993, passed away Oct. 18 after a long illness. During his productive career, his paintings and drawings were exhibited nationally and are represented in a number of collections. He held a bachelor's degree from Kansas State University and a master's degree in fine arts from Indiana University. Among his other distinctions: being on the faculty of World Campus Afloat in 1970, teaching and traveling throughout Europe and South America. Before his death, he donated 42 pieces of his personal art collection to PJC's art department.
