17-Day Central Europe Tour Set for Summer January 23, 2006

PENSACOLA —The University of West Florida Division of Continuing Education and Department of History will offer a travel/tour course, "Central Europe—Centuries of Contrast," June 29 through July 16. Daniel Miller, professor of History, and a guide from the region will lead the tour, which will visit Prague, Czech Republic; Vienna, Austria; Bratislava, Slovakia; Tatra National Park, Slovakia; Cracow and Auschwitz, Poland; Dresden, Germany; and Berlin, Germany.

"This is more than a tour," Miller said. "Travelers will visit some of the most beautiful cities in the world and explore parts of Central Europe that most Americans who come to the region never see."

Highlights of the trip will include the opportunity to explore the eastern and western parts of Berlin, become acquainted with Dresden, which was rebuilt from the ashes of the Second World War, and visit the former Nazi concentration camps at Auschwitz and Birkenau. Travelers can take advantage of the cultural and artistic attractions in each city on the tour, including the celebrations of Dresden's 800th birthday and Mozart's 250th birthday in Vienna.

Miller will present three pre-departure lectures in the conference room of the UWF Department of History, Building 50, Feb. 4 and 25, as well as March 18 from 10 a.m. to noon.

Enrollment is open to undergraduate and graduate students (three credits), and audits are available for those who are not seeking a degree. The price of the trip is \$4,600 if 11 to 15 students enroll or \$4,600 for 8 to 10 participants. Air transportation (from and to Pensacola), ground transportation, all hotels, admission to Prague Castle and about half the meals are included in the price. Out-of-state students pay the same price as in-state students for the credits and the tour. Deposits are due on or before March 31.
